**The first award**

**Vocational Training Corporation**

**For Its two projects**

***"Promotion of training to improve efficiency in the water and energy sectors" (Training for Water and Energy Efficiency Development- TWEED)***

This project is designed to meet the growing demand among companies for trained skilled workforce to meet the requirements. Recently, there has been a lack of qualified professionals in the field of water and energy efficiency. The Vocational Training Corporation (VTC) is the main implementing partner in this project, which contributes to more efficient use of water and energy in the construction sector through market-oriented professional training.

***"Integrate and train persons with disabilities for employment"***

Within the framework of the VTC mandate to carry out its national duty and vocational training for all segments and components of the Jordanian society including persons with disabilities, it aims through this project to achieve training objectives that meet the needs of this segment and labour market.

For its project**

***"Training of Jordanians and Syrian refugees with special needs on mosaic crafts & rehabilitating them for work"***

This project aims to train a number of Jordanians and Syrian refugees with physical disabilities for the production of mosaics, which is considered a suitable craft convenient for their health situation, as it does not need many equipment and tools.
